The Cutaneous Lymphoma Foundation is pleased to announce we are soliciting applications for our Young Investigator Award for the American Society of Hematology Annual Meeting (ASH) to be held December 6 - 9, 2025 in Orlando, Florida.

This award, a \$1,500 honorarium, supports the travel of a young investigator who is attending the ASH Annual Meeting and is presenting cutaneous lymphoma-related research.

Criteria for selection of the Young Investigator Award includes:

- Individuals with an M.D. or Ph.D. degree.
- Individuals with an academic rank no greater than assistant professor and within three years of first faculty appointment.
- Individuals with demonstrable interest and/or achievement in clinical care, education or research in cutaneous lymphomas.
- Individuals who have submitted an abstract and will be presenting research at the 2025 ASH meeting.
